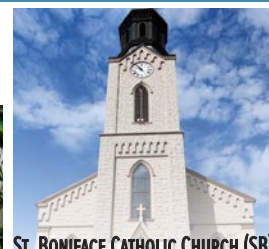

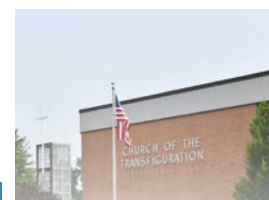

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN RAMBLINGS

Praised be Jesus Christ, now and forever!

I had the privilege of serving as chaplain for Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes' 8th grade students on their Confirmation Retreat at Damascus last week. It was a joyful, Christ-filled and Christ-centered moment for our young people. It was such an amazing weekend, and I was so proud of our young people opening their hearts to Jesus even more. Some of the missionaries approached me and our chaperones to compliment our 8th graders specifically on their knowledge and love of Him. Please pray for our Confirmands who will be Confirmed in the faith on February 7. As amazing as the weekend was, it started on a sour note, as I received notice that the steam boiler that provides heat to St. Boniface Catholic Church reached what was described as "catastrophic failure." Our staff is working with several companies to properly provide information for our options moving forward. The two options before us are both very expensive. We will provide more information as final decisions are made. In the meantime, all St. Boniface Masses will now be held at St. Mary until further notice:

The Mass times, the ministers, sacristans, ushers, servers, Mass intentions, collections will all remain the same. My recent announcement to the faithful is on the previous page. To be very clear, there has been no discussion, nor is there a current intention to close ANY of our five churches. I deeply appreciate your willingness to cooperate and accommodate the location adjustment, as it is TEMPORARY. Please trust in the Holy Spirit to continue to guide and lead us. We feel blessed to have a place to worship Him, and even in the same city.

We will be providing regular, official updates as "Announcements to the Faithful" through the Our Lady of Fatima's Facebook page, Piqua Parishes' website and through communication at Mass when warranted.

As our beautiful churches age, it's important to have deferred maintenance plans in place to uphold and sustain the function, safety and beauty of these properties. We are pleased to be able to soon move forward through the phases of a St. Patrick capital project that has been on the horizon for more than a dozen years. More information about the launch of that will soon follow!

CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

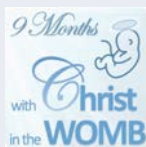
OLF will hold a second collection next weekend. The Catholic Church teaches, through Scripture and the example of saints like Francis of Assisi, that creation is a gift from God and that humanity has a duty to care for it for the good of all, including future generations. Today, pollution, climate change, and harmful agricultural practices threaten this gift. In response, Pope Francis issued *Laudato Si'* (2015), calling the world to pursue "sustainable and integral development" through cooperation and respect for creation.

This vision inspires organizations like La Cosecha Community Supported Agriculture in Albuquerque, New Mexico, which provides sustainable, locally grown food to low-income families. With help from the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD), La Cosecha has expanded to 11 rural counties, increased year-round access to healthy food, and earned USDA food-safety certification.

CCHD-funded groups demonstrate how we can protect the environment, fight poverty, and strengthen local economies. Twenty-five percent stays within your diocese to support local anti-poverty efforts. Learn more at www.usccb.org/cchd.

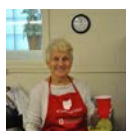

DID YOU KNOW? A "QR CODE" TUTORIAL

1. What Is It?
 - A QR code is a small square picture made of black and white dots.
 - It works like a shortcut — when you scan it with your phone camera, it quickly takes you to the website, video or message without typing anything.
2. How to Scan It
 - Open your Camera app.
 - Point your phone's camera at the QR code. (Make sure the whole square fits on the screen.)
3. What to Do Next
 - Wait a moment; a link or message will pop up on your screen.
 - Tap the link to open it and see the information.
