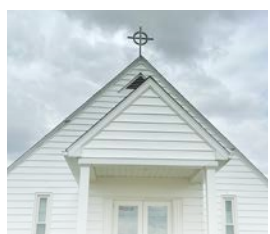

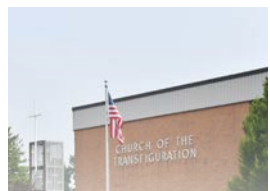

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS – APRIL 26, 2026

The Catholic Church will observe the World Day of Prayer for Vocations on Sunday, April 26, 2026, inviting the faithful to pray that the Lord "send out laborers for His harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2) and to support a culture of vocational discernment.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN RAMBLINGS

I want to share an excerpt from Dynamic Catholic with you about God drawing near to us.

“ We have a desire to draw near to God...sometimes. God has a desire to draw near to us **all the time**. God is always present in our lives. Sometimes He may seem hidden, sometimes He may seem hard to find, but He’s always there. And in the story of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, we have an epic example of God’s unfailing presence in our lives. Let’s go through this story together. Since it is a bit long, we’ll pause as we go through it to explore some of its key lessons. Pay close attention to all the ways God’s presence is active in the story.

“That very day, two of them were going to a village named Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus Himself drew near, and went with them.”

So there’s two incredibly powerful things here already. First, notice the disciples are walking away from Jerusalem. Jesus, their friend, their teacher, their savior has just died an unjust death. They believed He had come to redeem the world but, from their perspective, His death is a crushing blow. Whether they are driven by fear for their lives or the disappointment of their belief that Jesus was the Messiah, they are walking away from the other disciples and from the last place they encountered Jesus. Have you ever been disappointed in God’s plan for you? How are you walking away from Him right now? When you are confused and afraid, is your tendency to run toward God or away from Him?

The second thing to notice is the line, “When Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.” God yearns to draw near to us. Even when we don’t yearn to draw nearer to Him, He’s constantly drawing nearer to us. Even when we are full of uncertainty, disappointment, frustration and fear, God comes to walk alongside us. “But their eyes were kept from recognizing him.” You could spend the rest of your life thinking and praying about this one line. Often, we are blind to God’s presence in our lives. What is keeping you from recognizing God’s presence in your life right now? Are you distracted by trivial things? Are you too busy to spend time with Him? Is there a source of stress or anxiety you have yet to lay at His feet?

Next, they ask Jesus to stay with them. Even though they’re unaware that this is Jesus before them, they sense He is someone special. When was the last time you said to Jesus, “Stay with me”? When was the last time you invited Jesus powerfully into your life? God always yearns to draw near to us, but we still have to open the door of our hearts to Him.

“When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to them. And their eyes were opened and they recognized him; and he vanished out of their sight.”

Their eyes were opened. And how does it happen? Through the Eucharist. Jesus has walked with them on the road, He’s been revealed to them in the Scriptures, but it is through the breaking of bread that they finally come to see His true presence. In what way do you need your eyes to be opened today? In what ways do you need God to open your eyes to His presence in your life? To His blessings in your life? To the providence that might be in a circumstance or a situation that you’re experiencing right now that maybe you resent? Whatever it is, what do you think will happen if you bring it to Jesus in the Eucharist?

God is with us. That is the message of this powerful story. God is with us. He’s there walking alongside us in the moments and circumstances of our day. He’s there in the Scriptures, speaking to our hearts. And He’s there in the Eucharist, waiting to enter our souls.

Let’s ask Him to open our eyes so we can recognize Him a little bit more today. ”
