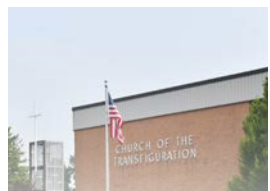

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Christ, The Good Shepherd

Jesus said: "The shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger, they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers." Christ Himself is the Good Shepherd, who knows each one of His sheep, who gives His life for them and snatches them from the jaws of the marauding wolf. He is the true shepherd who fulfills Ezekiel's prophecy foretelling for Israel a shepherd from the end of time who was to deliver his people.

Christ's sheepfold is the Church. In the Church, He bestows on us His life in the Sacraments, His word in the teaching that She gives us, all the riches of His grace to light up our way and uphold our steps as we go forward to our heavenly home; through Her, He acts as the one Shepherd of our souls. Appointed to lead the flock, Peter gave his life for those entrusted to his care, and, ever since then, the priestly ministry has assured the continuous presence in the Church of Him who remains the true Shepherd of our souls.

"Guided and protected by the Risen Jesus, we celebrate on the fourth Sunday of Easter – also called "Good Shepherd Sunday" – the 63rd World Day of Prayer for Vocations. It is an occasion of grace in which we share some reflections on the interior dimension of vocation, understood as the discovery of God's free gift that blossoms in the depths of our hearts. Let us explore together the truly beautiful path of life along which the Shepherd guides us." (Pope Leo)

Following the lead of our Holy Father, may we commit ourselves to praying for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, religious life and holy, sacred marriages.

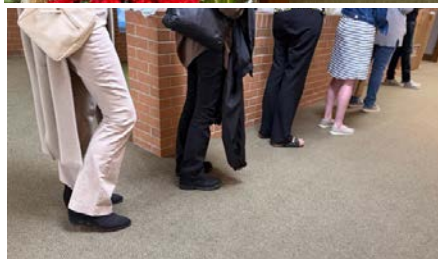


Mark your calendars for this year's **Rosary Walks** hosted at the Transfiguration Center at the Lange Estate:

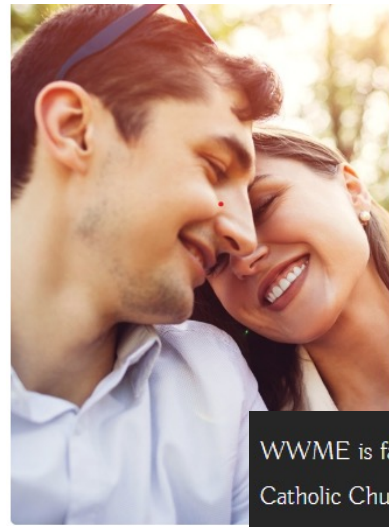

The April 10th Seniors Alive was attended by a total of 72 persons. The program presented by Linda Weikert Daniel and her brother Tim Weikert was about their Uncle Roy Weikert, It was interesting, informative and fun as they shared stories about their uncle's humble

beginnings, his intellectual curiosity and with a belief that anything conceivable is achievable, he innovated product and manufacturing ideas in the plastics packaging industry as early as 1939. He served in the Army during WWII and after the war, in 1947 he began building a business from the ground up, General Films Inc in Covington. Tim Weikert is CEO of General Films and it continues to be an industry leader today.

As a young man, Roy researched healthy lifestyles and proceeded to implement a lifestyle of good nutrition, proper rest and regular exercise which contributed to Roy living to be 105. He bungee jumped at the age of 81, walked 2 to 3 miles a day, played tennis and loved dancing and music.

The program and name, Seniors Alive, is attributed to Roy's active life. The Roy J. Weikert Trust fund allocation to the Church the Brethren is the major underwriter for this fun Outreach Program.
