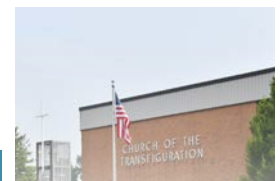

PARISHIONER CONTACT INFO: Be sure to keep your address, phone number and e-mail up-to-date with your registered church, so you don't miss important things.

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

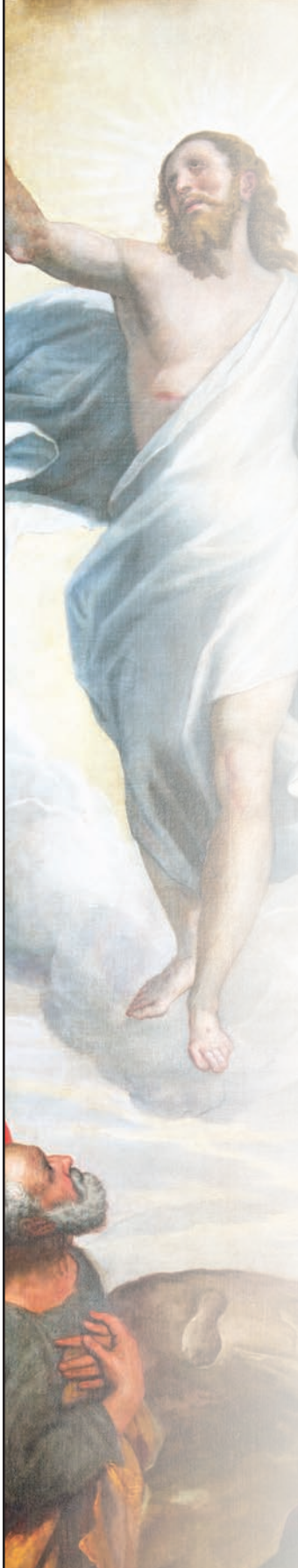

Ascension of Our Lord

On this Ascension Sunday, we discover many things perhaps too wonderful to grasp all at once. The Disciples' witness of Christ rising into heaven invites us to recognize that for anyone to truly understand and digest the meaning of this Sunday, we must be nowhere else other than with the Disciples. To be with the Disciples' means to be in a state of stillness watching Jesus rise. His rising carries all manners of baggage. Not the poor kind, but the kind that empowers and supports one on a pilgrimage through life. Something akin to that luggage that provides you with the confidence to leave the fortress of your own home and take on the world for a few days.

Christ's Ascension impels us to remember the goodness that God the Father lowered divinity to man in a manner not seen before in history and not seen since; "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." (Jn 3:16) This great act brings to mind one of the most iconic lines of one of the most popular and contemporary saints, St. Pier Giorgi Frassati. He spoke the memorable words, "Verso L'alto." This latin phrase means simply "To the heights." As a disciple of Christ, he was a deeply adventurous man, intent on navigating the pathways of the surrounding mountains and the alleyways of human hearts living around him. At age 24, he died from polio. Many might say he was taken too early. As a saint, what regrets did he have when he had loved so many in such a short amount of time? He recognized the meaning of the gift of time and had used it well. How could he want for more when his work was finished and God was finally calling him home? His death revealed his character, and the power of Christ's work in the world. His death also admitted of the need, and invitation of others to take up the call of Christ's loving and salvific work. God sent Jesus to earth that man might know He was made for something higher. God "lowered" Himself to breath life into St. Frassati's soul 24 years earlier so that, 24 years later, the world could have another model of virtue in the heights of heaven.

God mediated His love through Jesus and the Disciples that we might know of the Resurrection, the Ascension, and the implications of such wondrous mysteries. God mediated His love through St. Frassati that mankind might know of the heights of such love. A love desirous to descend to the depths of the human heart for its own sake, can't help but also raise the broken and burdened heart to the pinnacle of freedom as well. A heart on fire for love desires to get out of the way and to let others experience the light of Christ's love without hindrance. St. Frassati did not mind dying at 24 because he, like every other saint, knows that true life is all about Christ and getting out of the way of love. And the paradoxically beautiful thing? Christ can't help but include others in His life of love. Christ's Ascension reminds us that His Way leads us to get out of the way of love and this is one of our truest desires. Can we imagine a life where we let love roam free in the world of our hearts and did nothing to impede its travels? What adventures could we hear, and see for ourselves? Where are we called to help others see "Verso L'alto" all the way? The Ascension reminds us to stop and rest in the mysteries which transpired that gift us the privilege to see with the Disciples' something of the glory of God. May God bless all of you in this Easter season of Apostleship and may all witness the heights to which Christ brings those prayers that exist in the depths of your heart.
