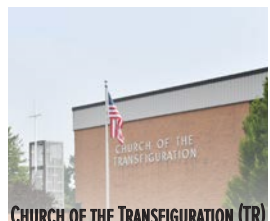

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CONTACT YOUR CHURCH OFFICE!

PARISHIONER CONTACT INFO: Be sure to keep your address, phone number and e-mail up-to-date with your registered church, so you don't miss important things.

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

VICAR'S VOICE BY FR. MARTIN BACHMAN

Pentecost of Our Lord

We are upon the end of the Easter Season with the celebration of Pentecost. It has been 50 days since our Lord's Resurrection, and now He is going to fulfill what was promised – to send the Holy Spirit upon His Church. We call the Holy Spirit the Paraclete from the Gospel of John. Paraclete means advocate, counselor, comforter, and helper sent by God to guide, strengthen, and support believers after Jesus' departure.

Every Sunday, we pray in the Nicene Creed:

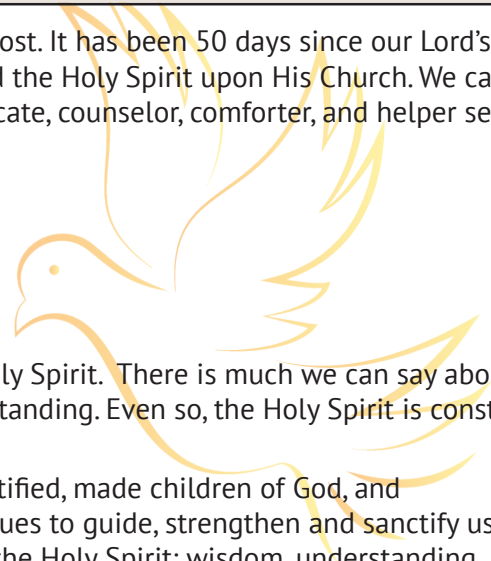
*"I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,
who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified,
who has spoken through the prophets."*

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. There is much we can say about the Holy Spirit, yet God always remains a mystery beyond our full understanding. Even so, the Holy Spirit is constantly at work in our lives and in the life of the Church.

We first receive the Holy Spirit in Baptism. Through Baptism, we are sanctified, made children of God, and incorporated into the life of Christ and His Church. The Holy Spirit continues to guide, strengthen and sanctify us throughout our lives. We also receive at Confirmation the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.

Saint Paul teaches that we can recognize the Holy Spirit at work within us through what he calls the fruits of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22). These fruits become visible in the way we live – in our families, in the Church, among our neighbors, in the workplace, in public life and even in the way we use social media.

So this Pentecost, let us reflect on the Holy Spirit. Let us call upon the Holy Spirit to guide us, help us in our struggles and discernment of how we are going to fulfill the call of all Christians, proclaiming Jesus Christ as Lord, for the Greater Glory of God.

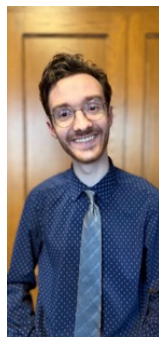

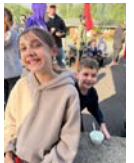

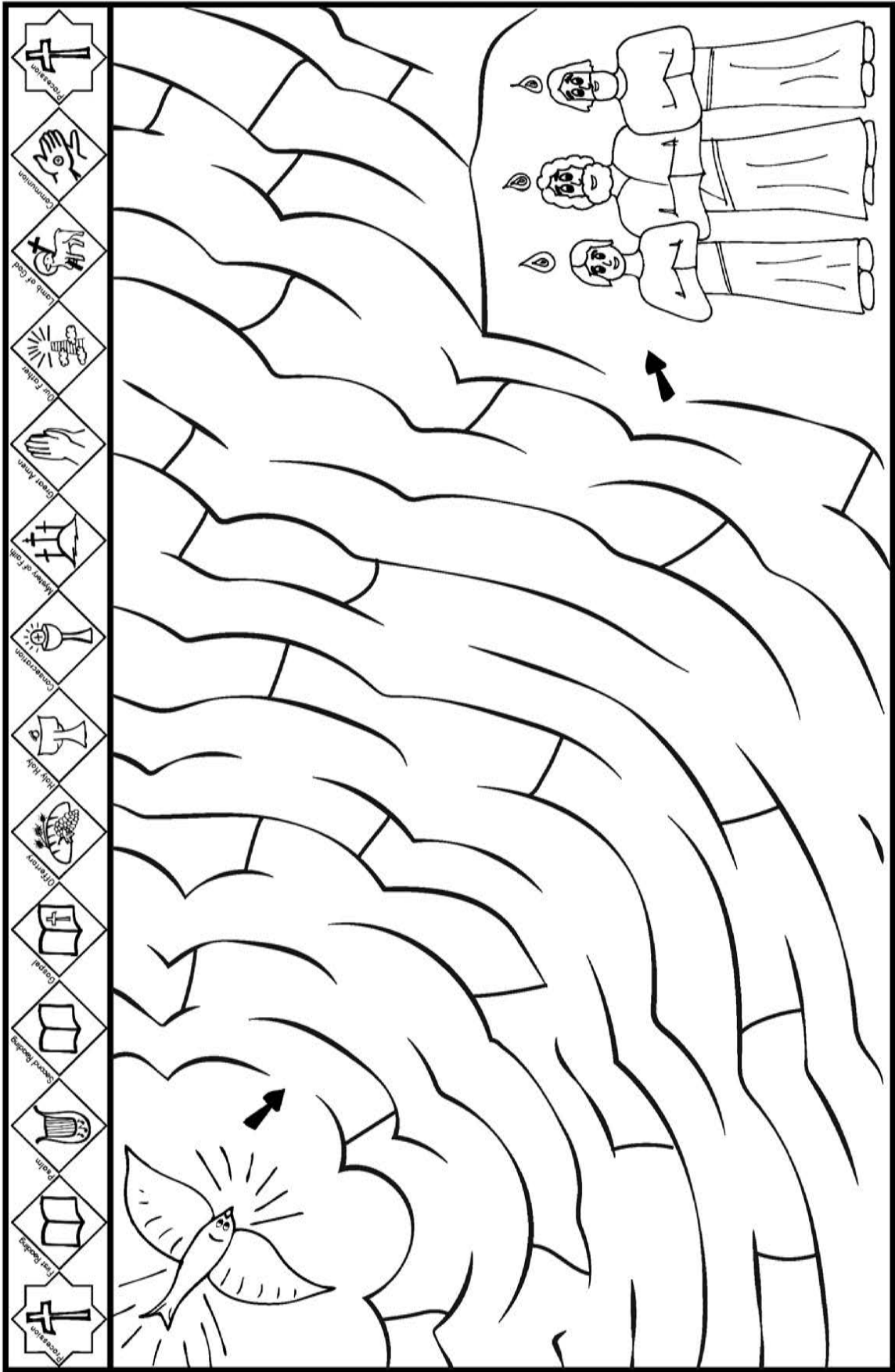
