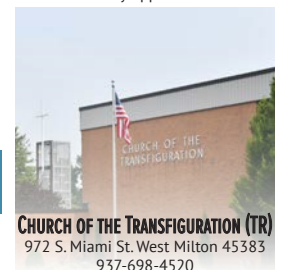

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

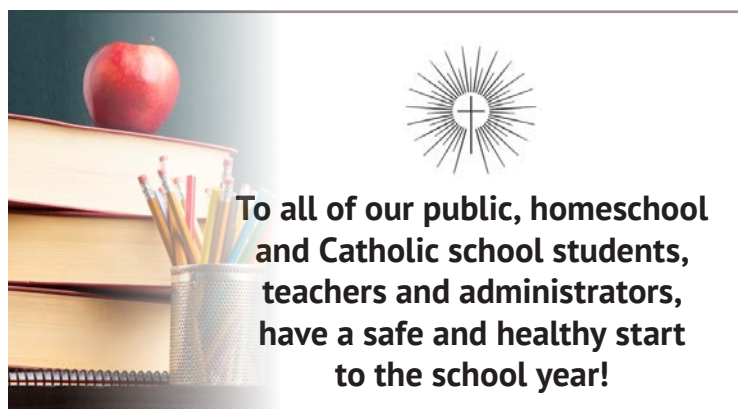

St. Boniface

As generous funding continues to be raised and committed to “Cherish Our Heritage” in support of maintenance and capital improvement at St. Boniface, here are some St. Boniface Capital Project updates:

The Wall Splits have been installed on the second floor of Downing Street Campus, which had been pulling from the old downstairs chiller and overworking it in the past - Just in time for school to start at Piqua Catholic!

The Rectory Roof & Gutters/Downspouts project has been approved to move forward with work by “Technical Roofing of St. Henry LLC” to begin later in October. This will include flat roof replacement, reworking of copper gutters around the building, new gutters and downspout. The next step following this will be fascia and stucco work.

New St. Boniface dire needs and major maintenance and replacement projects that have been discovered in recent weeks:

The chiller in the Caserta Center is not functioning properly and bids are being pursued. When pursuing repairs for a known leak in the church steeple, it was discovered that the church roof is badly in need of replacement. Quotes are being pursued.

St. Patrick

Parish Center Roof

Major leaking had been occurring in the roof of the Parish Center into classrooms and the library. The original roof was replaced over the summer.

Church Air Conditioning

The church requires up to five Air Conditioning units. This month, as you noticed, it went down to one fully operable one. SP Finance Council approved moving forward with the installation of two new units.

Phase III Capital Project

The custom widened door from Hemm’s Glass for the handicapped entrance has now arrived! Construction will be affecting the side hallway and tarps will be blocking the ramp door corner as installation occurs.

Phase II & III Capital Projects

The capstones and brick masonry to the sides of the main steps and the ramp footer walls will be added toward the end of the project. Due to the piping and intricate Snow Melt system installed to keep our visitors and parishioners safe, entry railings could not be added into the middle of the concrete steps without damaging the pipes. Side railings are mounted on the footer wall for those who require railings. Our beloved deceased may now have their casket carried up the steps with proper resting points as needed.

Did You Know?

OUR LADY OF FATIMA FAMILY OF PARISHES PRESENTS... ALTAR ROSARY SOCIETIES?

A Catholic Altar Rosary Society is a church support group that promotes devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary through the Rosary and supports the liturgical needs of the church. Typically comprised of women, members traditionally maintain altar linens, share funds with the church for sanctuary supplies and perform charitable and social work within the church community.

- **Spiritual Growth:** Members regularly gather to pray the Rosary, foster personal sanctification and build community through shared faith.
- **Altar Care:** Often one of the oldest active ministries in a parish, the society takes responsibility of the sanctuary. Duties typically include cleaning altars, laundering linens, paying for candles, hosts and sacramental wine.
- **Service & Charity:** Members frequently host fundraising events (such as bake sales and craft fairs), organize funeral receptions, and provide spiritual or material support to the sick and local charities.

History These societies historically were local chapters affiliated with the global Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary, an organization established by the Dominican Order in the 15th century. While historical roots sometimes limited membership exclusively to married women, modern societies are generally open to all adult men and women in the parish. The name has various forms such as Rosary Altar Society, Rosary & Altar Society or Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary - all with a similar purpose. 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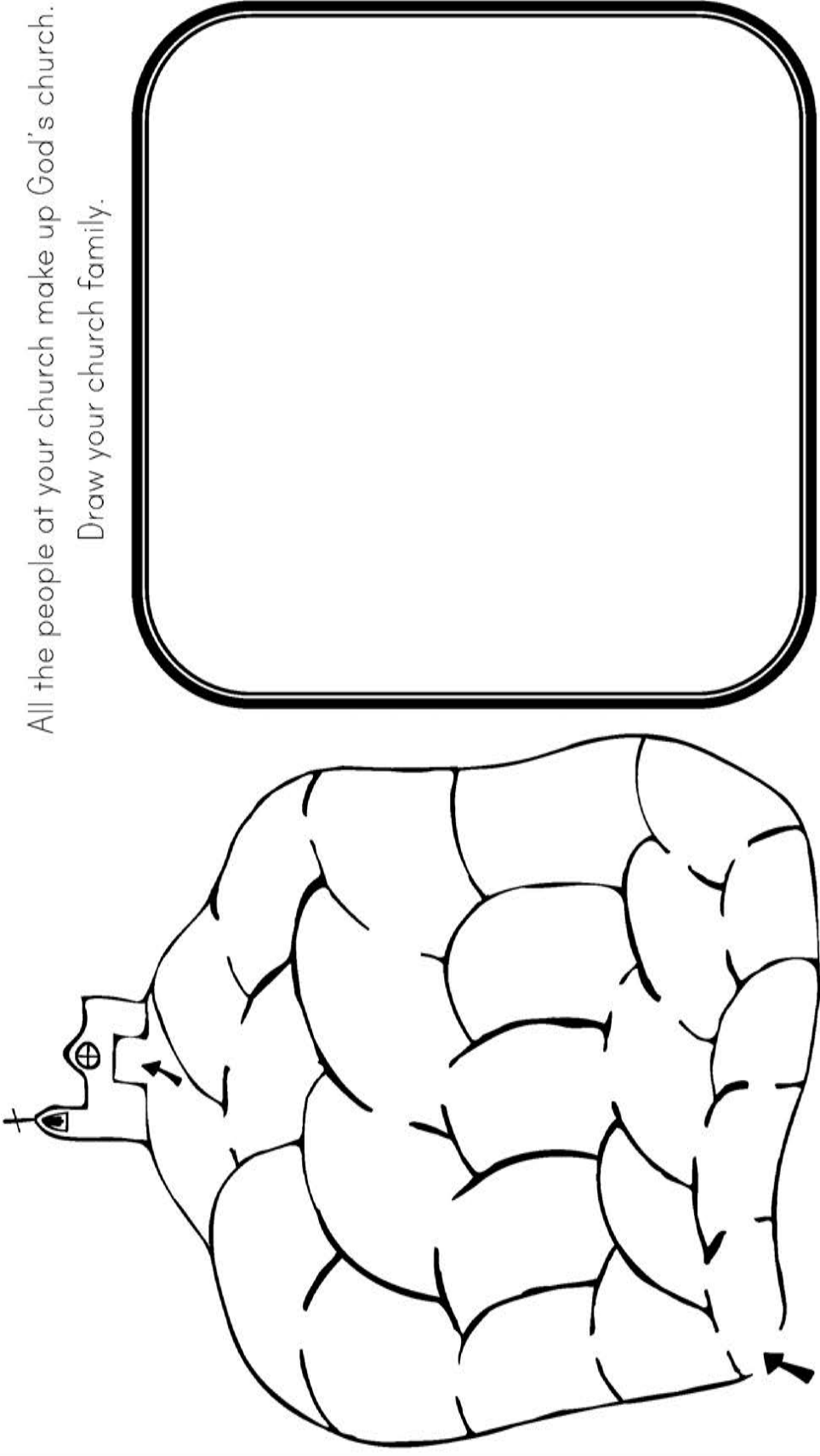
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
